

REPORT ON NDLI AWARENESS SESSION HOSTED BY CRKIMR LIBRARY COMMITTEE

Chetana's R. K. Institute of Management & Research Library Committee organized an awareness session about the “**National Digital Library of India**” on 2nd May 2022 hosted by **Library Student Committee members** under the guidance of **Dr. Siddhi Jagdale, Library Committee Head, CRKIMR Director Dr. Kalim Khan and NDLI Committee members Dr. Kavita Khadse, Dr. Shivaprasad Murugan, and Dr. Balaji Sadavarte** were invited as guest speakers for the session. The session was attended by first-year MMS students of batch 2021-23. The session was started by welcoming the guest. Dr. Kalim Khan inaugurated the first event of the library committee i.e. NDLI awareness session. He guided the students by sharing the advantages of library digitalization, the change in technology from the library's point of view, and how the students can use the NDLI portal in their upcoming projects. He also shared the importance of reading books in the present era. Dr. Balaji Sadavarte as part of the NDLI committee shared the motive and objectives of NDLI with students and quoted some examples regarding the use of the NDLI portal. He also emphasized using the portal for the research papers which will be helping the students in their careers and will provide a niche over others. Dr. Kavita Khadse congratulated the library committee for their first event and appealed to use the NDLI portal for the students. The student committee members proposed a detailed presentation on the NDLI web portal, its interface, and various options present on the portal as well as on the app that will ease their use of the portal. An introduction to the NDLI club was given which included the registration and login to the club portal, and an explanation of the various features such as events and rewards. The objectives of the NDLI club were explained to the students which will enhance their core competencies and also the importance of the culture of reading and learning was emphasized. A quiz competition was taken by the library committee related to the NDLI portal to check the current awareness about the world among the students.

The session was followed by a question-and-answer session where students asked queries about the portal and NDLI club. Committee made sure that each student's question was answered. Student Committee members proposed a vote of thanks to the guest and the session ended.
